Growing Notes

Our 2019 Sonoma Coast pinot noir is a special barrel selection from the Thorn Ridge Vineyard, Rice-Spivak Vineyard, and Emmaline Ann Vineyard. Each year, Katy Wilson crafts our Sonoma Coast blend to be a wine you can enjoy upon release or cellar for years.

The 2019 vintage is very expressive with captivating aromas and flavors. During the third week of May, we had heavy rains, which is quite unusual for our area. The rains were followed by moderate and warm, dry weather in the summer and fall, which provided ideal growing conditions. We were fortunate in that we had finished picking before the Kincadee fire started. There were power outages in our area, but our winery had back up power, so we were able to keep our fermentations going smoothly.

Tasting Notes

This wine opens with subtle notes of violets, cardamom, & turned earth, evolving into juicy notes of Rainier cherry, raspberry, & strawberry. Lightly toasted oak is feathered into flavors of sweet cherry, cranberry, and plum. Tannins are well integrated and balanced with the acidity leaving a lasting and charming finish.
