Growing Notes

Bedrock Vineyard is one of the most historically and qualitatively gilded plots of land in Sonoma Valley. Taking up 152 acres of the heart of Sonoma Valley, the vineyard occupies a large section of one of the best-growing climates for grapes on earth. Founded in 1854, Bedrock Vineyard has grown grapes for over 150 years and is currently owned and farmed by the Peterson Family (Bedrock Wine Co.). It is a privilege to work with such a rich piece of Californian history. Bedrock's understanding of farming and preserving old vines has provided a blueprint for more recent restorations around the state.

In 2021, we started the year with great anticipation after the devastating 2020 vintage where we did not harvest anything. The season started off with a mild winter and some unusually warm days in January. Despite the sporadic warm weather, budbreak happened at a normal time in mid-March. We had moderate temperatures in the spring and summer. The harvest started in early September and we were finished before the end of the month. Due to the balanced climate and yields, quality was fantastic and we think that it is one of our best vintages.

Tasting Notes

This Sonoma Valley Cabernet Sauvignon opens with aromas of juicy dark fruits of blueberry and blackberry mixed with muddled raspberry. Delicate oak spices and a hint of hazelnut are intertwined with floral notes of red violets. On the palate, fresh and vibrant tannins blend with baking spices of cinnamon, nutmeg, and clove.
