#### Growing Notes

Katy Wilson teamed up with Ted Klopp and Lauren Klopp Williams (also of Thorn Ridge Vineyard) in the planting of this coastal vineyard. The combination of the Goldridge sandy loam soils and coastal climate lends to wines with great complexity of minerality and high levels of acidity.

In 2023, we had a lot of rainfall and most of California came out of a long drought. There was plenty of snowpack in the mountains. We had a very cool spring with only a few warm spells in April and May. We also had some late rains in May and June. The weather during flowering was foggy and cool. The harvest came late with ample hang time on the vines, which gave us wines with great complexity and development. The yields were average and balanced. Overall, we are looking forward to showcasing this outstanding and noteworthy vintage.

#### Tasting Notes

Lemon blossom, Granny Smith apple, passionfruit, and subtle white lily grace the nose. The palate is touched with mouthwatering acidity that intertwines effortlessly with beautiful coastal lemon, yellow lime, and subtle oak notes of vanilla and caramel that linger long after the last sip.
