Bedrock Vineyard is one of the most historically and qualitatively gilded plots of land in Sonoma Valley. Taking up 152 acres of the heart of Sonoma Valley, the vineyard occupies a large section of one of the best-growing climates for grapes on earth. Founded in 1854, Bedrock Vineyard has grown grapes for over 150 years and is currently owned and farmed by the Peterson Family (Bedrock Wine Co.). It is a privilege to work with such a rich piece of California history. Bedrock's understanding of farming and preserving old vines has provided a blueprint for more recent restorations around the state.

In 2023, we had a lot of rainfall and most of California came out of a long drought. There was plenty of snowpack in the mountains. We had a very cool spring with only a few warm spells in April and May. We also had some late rains in May and June. The weather during flowering was foggy and cool. The harvest came late with ample hang time on the vines, which gave us wines with great complexity and development.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of dark blueberry and crushed violet are accented by hints of vanilla bean. Concentrated blackberry and blueberry carry through on the palate, while the finish lingers with notes of toasted vanilla, ripe fruit, and beautifully textured tannins.
