Growing Notes

Our 2024 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir is a special barrel selection from the Thorn Ridge Vineyard and Rice-Spivak Vineyard. Each year, Katy Wilson crafts our Sonoma Coast blend to be a wine you can enjoy upon release or cellar for years.

The 2024 season started with budbreak in early March. We had some big storms in January and many rainy days in February. Flowering started on the early side and was finished by the beginning June. Warm July days pushed the grapes through veraison quickly. Harvest kicked off on August 31st with our Sauvignon Blanc and we finished with our Chardonnay from Charles Heintz Vineyard on October 1st. The weather allowed us to be selective with our harvest dates. We were able to pick at a time with optimal flavor development and balance. The 2024 vintage was outstanding and we look forward to sharing these lovely wines with you.

Tasting Notes

The 2024 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir opens with layered aromas of forest floor, Rainier cherry, raspberry, pressed pomegranate, clove, and warm baking spices. Hints of fresh strawberry and just-ripe plum add brightness and depth. On the palate, vibrant acidity carries flavors of black cherry and cranberry. The wine is textured and energetic, balancing intense fruit with fine tannins and a long, nuanced finish.
